Volunteer at the Library!

The library offers the following opportunity for New Westminster teens to gain volunteer experience.

READING BUDDIES (13-18 years)

English and French reading buddies run Sep-Nov and Jan-Mar one hour per week, after school. Volunteers read one-on-one with 6-to-9-year-olds who already know how to read. This is reading practice, not reading instruction. Registration begins the first open day of September and January. Apply at the youth services desk.

NEWCOMER BUDDIES (13-18 years)

Runs through the school year (check library for current session dates) after school, in a one-hour session, once per week. Teens help newly arrived refugees and immigrants aged 5-18 years, adapt to life in Canada. Activities focus on language, homework and fun! Registration is ongoing. Apply at the youth services desk.

TEEN TECH TUTORS (13-18 years)

Teens volunteer in Tech Tutorial sessions held at the library where they work one-on-one with an adult learner. A librarian supervises the session and provides instruction. Teens are there to assist the adult learner with skills taught by the librarian. You must have solid computer skills to volunteer for this program. Apply at the youth services desk.

TEEN ADVISORY GROUP (13-18 years)

Teens meet monthly to discuss teen programming, teen collections, and to occasionally shop for teen materials for the library!
